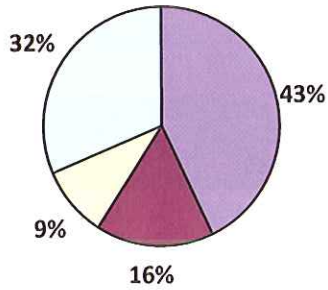

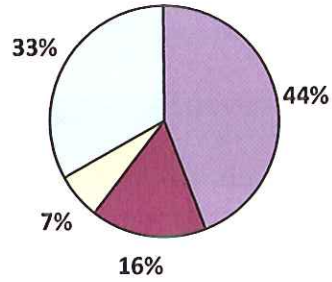
TOTAL COST OF CARE BY CLAIM TYPE

Peer Group's Risk Adjusted PMPM Distribution

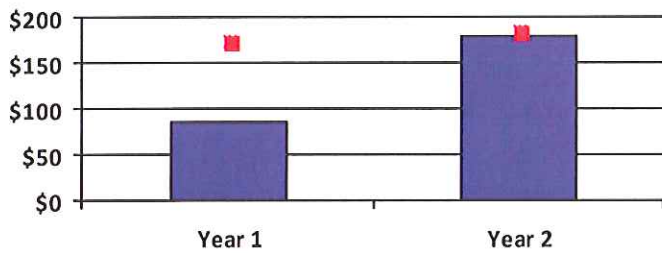

TOTAL COST OF CARE BY AGE COHORT

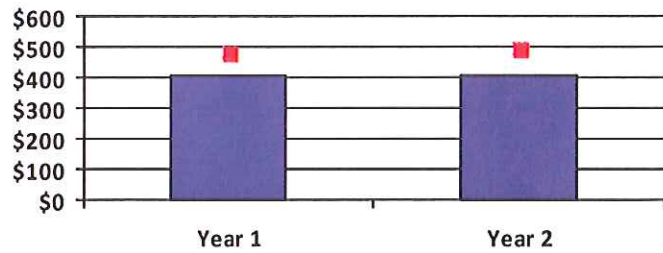
Pediatric Total Cost of Care Trend
